Summer Exam Period



The summer exam period for Year 11, 12 & 13 begins on Monday.

Year 11 have been informed about a programme of support in order to facilitate additional revision time and to promote wellbeing during exams. The following measures will be in place:

- The building will be open for 'light-touch' revision and breakfast from 7:45am
- Year 11 timetables have been adjusted so all students have a subject specific session and time with their teacher directly before their exam
- Lunch will have an earlier start time of 12:30pm, where students are sitting an afternoon exam
- In preparation for next week's Maths and Science GCSE exams we are running intervention tomorrow at 9:00am-12:00pm and 12:30pm-3:30pm. All of Year 11 should attend both sessions.

Year 13 and Year 12 students should remain onsite all day making use of the library and independent study facilities. Many subjects are already running additional catch-up and revision sessions and students are expected to attend these.

Students with **exams in the morning** are advised to arrive for exam-prep at 8am and **must not be onsite any later than 8:30am.**

Full exam timetables and procedures have been distributed to all students and sent home to Year 11 parents.
