RE: Year 10 Physical Education

Physical Education (PE) is a compulsory part of the curriculum for all pupils at every Key Stage, from age four to 16. Physical Education provides opportunities for students to become physically confident in a way which supports their health and fitness. Opportunities to participate in physical activities also supports students in building character and helps to embed values such as fairness and respect.

At Mulberry UTC we strive to provide a high-quality physical education curriculum. We source our physical education from trusted, local, offsite providers.

This academic year students in Year 10 have their timetabled Physical Education lessons on Tuesday afternoons. For the autumn 1 term, these lessons are held offsite at Laburnum Boat Club (Laburnum St, London E2 8BH) and students will be participating in rock climbing and kayaking.

Students were given a letter on Friday 2nd September detailing the activity and the clothing required to participate. Students are expected to bring their MUTC P.E. kit for every P.E. lesson, which includes plain tracksuit bottoms, t-shirt, sweatshirt and solid sole shoes, trainers are ideal. It is of the upmost important that students are organised and remember their kit each week, to enable them to participate in their learning.

Students are accompanied and supervised by members of Mulberry UTC staff for the duration of their Physical Education lessons. This academic year we would like to ask for parental permission to dismiss students from the venue when the activity finishes at 3:30pm. Please can we ask that all parents/carers sign the attached permission form detailing their preference for dismissal. Students who are returning to the school building will have a slighter later school finish on a Tuesdays this half-term of 4-4:10pm (this is to allow for the return journey).
