As I am sure you are aware, the formal exam season begins on Monday 15th May and all students participating in exams and their parents should have received full information about the running of these exams. A reminder that students must report to the TV and Film Studio to be registered:

- No later than 8:20am for a morning exam
- No later than 1:00pm for an afternoon exam

Students who are late can be disqualified from the exam under JCQ regulations (the school does not have the power to prevent disqualification)

There are a number of interventions running, including a GCSE RE intervention this Saturday from 9:30am. You will be contacted about any intervention your child should be attending during the exam period.
