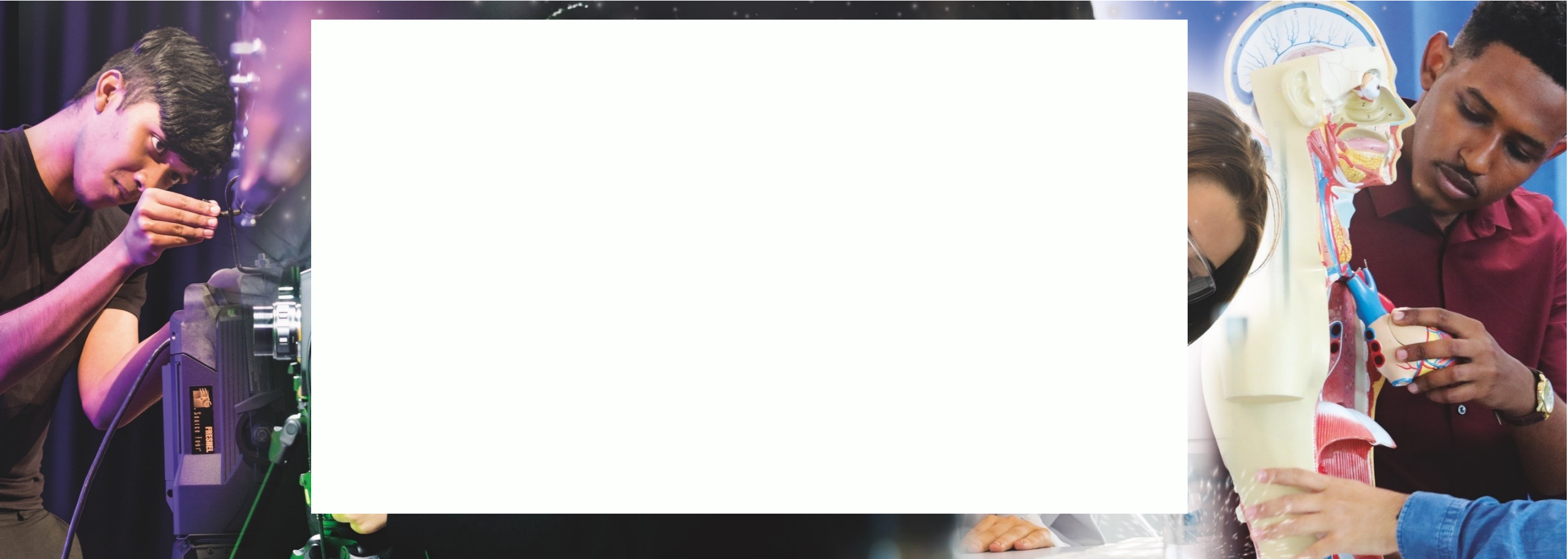

Mulberry UTC is a school for 14 to 19 year olds

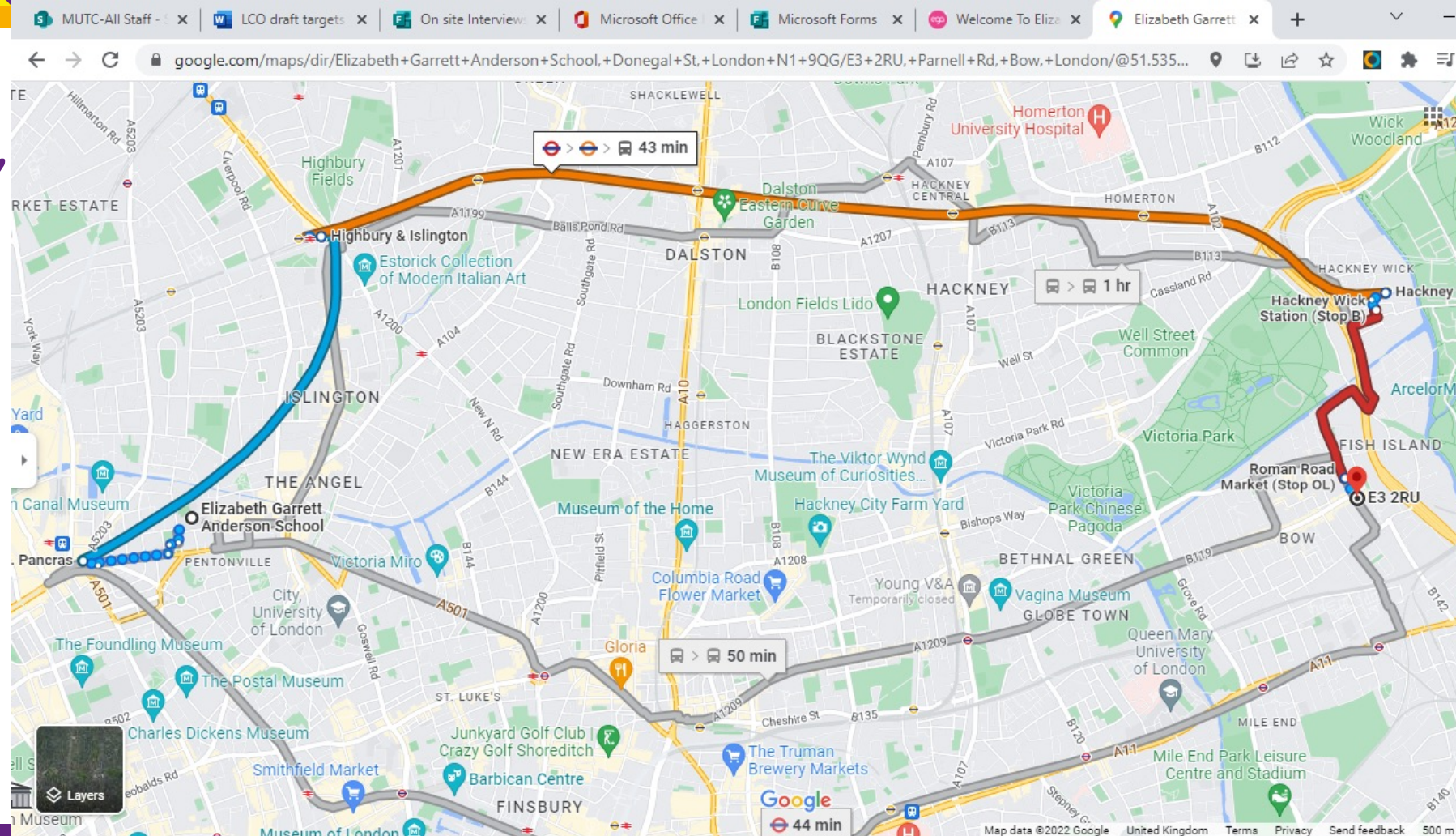
