- **The Lord of the Rings**
- **Classic / Disney fairy tales (e.g., Little Red Riding Hood, Snow White)**
- **Roald Dahl characters**
- **Alice in Wonderland**

Students who do not follow these guidelines may be asked to go home to change, have a parent bring appropriate clothing, or be placed in internal exclusion.

Additionally, students are asked to donate £1 on the day to Children in Need. Please note that card payments will not be accepted, so students should bring cash.
